

## Do you know the risk of chip bags?

**2-3 pets** die each week by suffocating in a snack bags.

It happens in as few as 3-5 minutes.

## You can prevent this.

Cut every single bag, every single time.

This commonly happens with chip or snack bags, but it can occur with bread or treat bags as well. Cut off the top and bottom of the bag, cut the bag into strips, or cut down the sides of the bag. The goal is to make it so that an animal cannot get their head trapped inside without air.

## Secure trash bins.

Use locking trash cans, or store your trash biin in a cabinet so that pets cannot access them.

Eat snacks out of a bowl.
Store snacks in resealable containers.
Learn pet CPR.

If the worst happens, knowing pet CPR could help save your pet's life.
